Introduction

Globally, the demand for education is growing

Expand the educated workforce [ie Vision 2016]

Use education as vehicle for social mobility

And deliver widespread economic growth (IFC 2010)



- Thus acknowledge role of science & research
- At individual level:
- Education gives a break for better employment
- Career mobility, better remuneration and social status
- In OECD countries relative earnings of tertiaryeducated adults is 1.5 times that of upper secondary education (OECD 2013).



The big question is whose responsibility is it to fund education

- Government (Tax payers)
- Parents, individuals (loans, savings etc) Motshelo??
- Civil society, Associations, interested groups ???
- Churches have a history of funding education
- Industry and private sector???

Importance of post-graduate training

 Training of post-graduate students is epicenter of generation of research and technology

- Dovetailing post-graduate training with research agenda, you achieve two goals;
- 1. Providing funds for higher education
- 2. Generating knowledge and technology




- Department Tertiary Education Financing (DTEF) currently not funding post-graduate akin to undergraduate scholarships
- Perhaps notion that government needs administrators and not innovators predominate even today.
- BUAN a public university should contribute to the national food systems by training at this level (PhD).
- Human Resource Development Council (HRDC) is live to importance of post-graduate funding & increasing national research outputs

Innovation Funding; What is it?

- The reviewer to the paper asked; does merely moving away from government subversion constitute innovation?
- The answer is YES
- When everyone in the village uses a sledge for transport and one chap decide to put wheels on the sledge; that's innovation
- The point here is any departure from the inefficient norm that improve outcomes is innovation

- Alumni is a very important university community.

- Recently graduated students, peer-to-peer fundraising is suitable >> social media animals and ICT savvy
- For older graduates, their social connection, network
 & experience come in handy



Agro-Business companies

 These have foremost business calling to support future agricultural scientists, innovators & farmers

Will result both monetary and non-monetary benefits

 Such companies are; BMC. BAMB, BVI, Botswana Kgalagadi Breweries, Food Botswana, milling companies



Botswana Meat Commission

- For emphasize, BMC will be used as a case study
- BMC has benefited from BUAN education [BAC >> BCA and BUAN; Boralopalo, Bakenti]
- Frontline drivers in beef through providing extension education

 BMC has duty to grow livestock industry through supporting post-graduate training >>adding value to its mandate



- Meat from grazed animals has more beneficial fats (omega-3) than from grain-fed animals and these benefits human health (Daley et al 2010
- This should be a marketing strength for Botswana beef.
- Empirical data needed to support this under Botswana's system. >>> unearthed by research
- Such strategic knowledge would propel known reputation Botswana Beef to higher level and thus command premier prices

Broad areas for BMC to collaborate with BUAN

- Production systems & breeds in different environments
- Effects of breed and nutrition on product (beef) quality
- High level beef genetics (molecular markers for economic value)
- Feedlot and grass effects on beef quality & product development
- Production efficiency, sustainability and carbon footprint
- Beef production economics and profitability
- Beef marketing research
- Cattle diseases



Other innovative ways

 Work for education; during undergraduate training or internship, companies place students in exchange to support their post-graduate training

 Before the advent of crowd funding Batswana were already doing it >> Motshelo

 University of Botswana use it in the 1970 before it became in vogue



- Setting up endowment investments for special project
- Sponsoring research chairs by private companies
- Examples; South Africa, ABSA Bank fund research chairs at UNISA and University of Pretoria at these institutions' business schools.

 From time to time NDB emphasize commitment to agriculture; here is the time to add value to that commitment



Challenges

- Partnering with external stakeholders may result in undue donor influence.
- Exerted on the selection of faculty or faculty chair during hiring,
- On program or course selection,
- On selection of heads of units, institutes
- And trampling on academic freedom.



 Policies that regulate donations, gifts and approval processes for donor-sponsored centres.

Policy for asset naming and philanthropy donation

 Open records policy will help and force BUAN to disclose the details of such donations to the law and public
